Governments agreed that the Regional Steering Group for CRVS in Asia and the Pacific would oversee the implementation of the outcomes of the Conference.

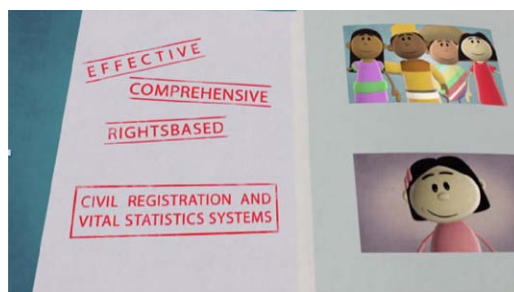
